MUSIC LEADER, CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP

- 1. Plan and lead contemporary worship service, Sundays 11:11am-12:10pm.
- 2. Choose music appropriate to Scripture lessons and preaching themes for each Sunday. Work in advance, as worship bulletins are reviewed at mid-week staff meetings.
- 3. Manage the contemporary worship band. Make sure you have enough and the appropriate voices and instruments for each service. Provide structure, leadership, organization, encouragement and a working understanding of the spiritual role of worship leadership.
- 4. Incorporate your ministry, presence and personality into worship life of the parish.
- 5. Maintain high standard of professional conduct and service.
- 6. Input song lyrics and liturgy pieces into projection system.
- 7. Understand and utilize sound system.
- 8. Be available for Christmas Eve worship service, 5pm, and potentially other evening services such as Holy Week.
- 9. Rehearse praise band one evening during the week and Sunday morning, 10:15-11am, prior to the service.
- 10. Maintain high skill level.
- 11. Maintain high standard of professional conduct.
- 12. Seek and develop professional contacts within and outside of the church.
- 13. Recruit new voices and musicians on a constant basis.

Upon acclimating to the life of the parish, work with Pastor Stelter in evaluating the contemporary worship service. Make suggestions and lead changes regarding flow, worship style, leadership, etc. Work with traditional worship music leaders collaboratively. Both services support each other and work for the same goal, to glorify God in worship and praise.
